



Selecting your Providence Medical Home

To take full advantage of your benefits you must first pick a primary care provider (PCP) medical home.

You don't need to pick a medical home for specialists. However, any specialist you see must be in-network to be covered under your medical plan. You can make your selection(s) using one of the following options.

What is a Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH)?

A medical home is a team-based model led by your primary care provider (PCP) and includes other health professionals like nurses, specialists, and pharmacists. This is called your "health care team." The members of your team work together to make sure they're all on the same page when it comes to your health.



There are three ways you can select a Medical Home:

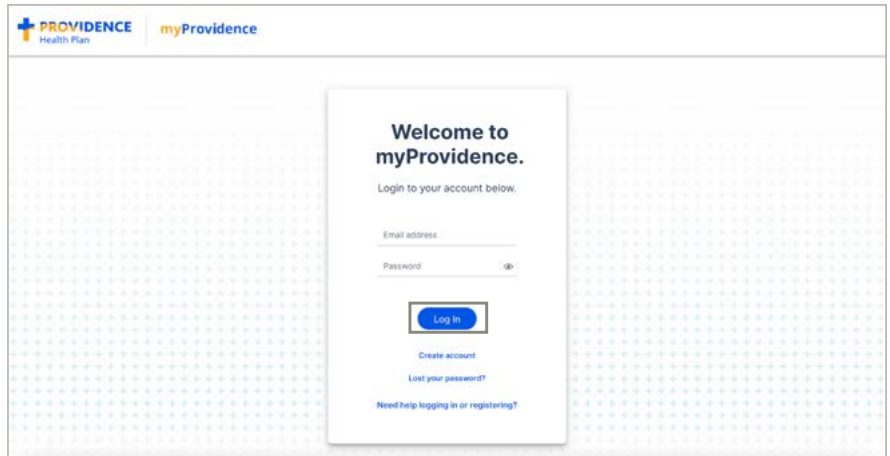

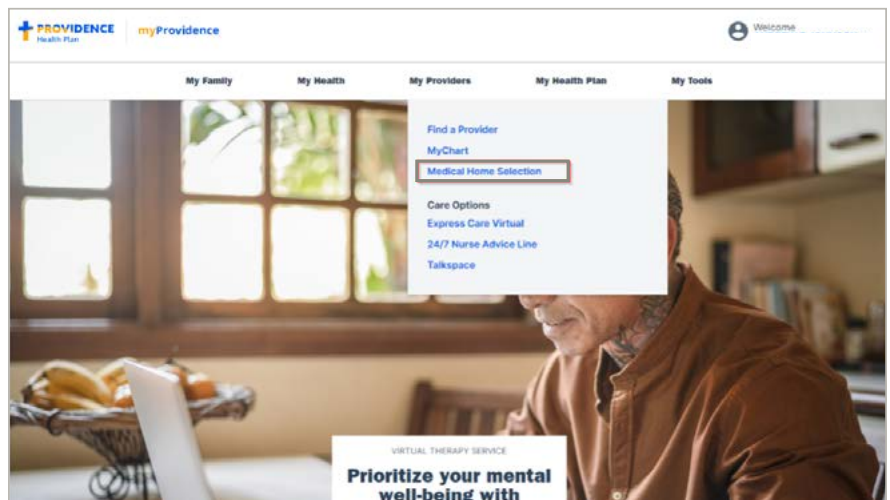
3. Through your [myProvidence.com](https://www.myprovidence.com) account or online medical home selection form
